Research staff, educators, managers and specialists of national and international companies in the field of transport and IT-technologies, school teachers, secondary and higher school students.


Each participant can submit one paper without co-authors and (or) no more than three papers in co-authorship.

Publication requirements

docx format,

- > font Times New Roman 11 pt,
- > margins: top, bottom, right, left - 2 cm,
- > page orientation - portrait, A4 format,
- > justified alignment,
- > indent 0.75 cm,
- > single line spacing,
- > 2 pages (min)-5 pages (max)

A manuscript should contain:

UDC (in the upper left corner, italics); a single line space, the title (centered, in capital letters, bold) in Russian and English. After a single line spacing - the initials and surnames of the authors in Russian and English (centered).

After a single line spacing - full name of the institution. A single line space - abstract and keywords in Russian (10 pt, indentation alignment). Then, a single line space - abstract and keywords in English (10 pt, indentation alignment).

A single line space. Full text of the paper. Figures (3 max) are placed in the text in *. bmp,* .tif, * .jpg, * .pcx, * .wmf formats. Tables are centered; the word Table is right-aligned, followed by the caption of the table (Times New Roman, 10 pt, centered), the text inside the table is typed in Times New Roman, 10 pt.

Legends are typed in Times New Roman, 10 pt, center alignment. References: section heading in Times New Roman, 11 pt, bold, center alignment. The list of references (10 max). References are made in accordance with GOST 7.0.5-2008 (non-textual references)

References

Only footnotes (in square brackets the number of the source in the list of references, separated by a colon - the page number, e.g. [1: 268]). REFERENCES ARE OBLIGATORY.

The main text of the article should have the following structure: introduction (explanation of the purpose and objectives), problem statement, methods for solving the problem, analysis of the results obtained, practical application of the results, conclusions, list of references.

All papers are checked for originality by the Antiplagiat software Expert (the recommended level of originality is 70%)

The organizing committee reserves the right to reject papers in cases of violation of the publication requirements, identification of incorrect borrowings, inconsistency of the publication with the scientific style, thematic range of the conference.
